Our NIPDP Values

Respect:

Treating everyone with dignity and respect and keeping their feelings, wishes, and rights in mind

Integrity:

Act with openness and honesty - acting in the best interest of the panel, and building trust through honest, transparent, and authentic discussions

Compassion:

Responding to others with kindness and humanity

Working Together:

Work with others and value everyone's contribution

Confidentiality:

Respect the purpose of the panel, give everyone space to air their opinion in a space of respect

Professionalism:

Everyone should act in a way that is appropriate to others

Objectivity:

Be objective to the discussion or topic, gain a better understanding of the topic by sharing information and viewpoints

Safe Space:

This is a safe space and everyone's contribution matters
